

Huizinga's definition of play

«Play is a voluntary activity or occupation executed within certain fixed limits of time and executed within certain fixed limits of time an place, according to rules freely accepted but absolutely binding, having its aim in itself and accompanied by a feeling of tension, joy and the consciousness that it is "different" from "ordinary life"» (Huizinga, 1938).


 A type of social space, separate time and space where all play takes place; The Magic Circle is so important that, according to

The Magic Circle









